

RLCC Annual Meeting February 6,2022

The meeting was called to order by Pastor Pam and she opened with prayer. There were 23 members in attendance. The Zoom feed was not working properly.

Installation Libby Gardner, Mark Schubert and Lori Floyd as new officers and standing committee members was lead by Pastor Pam.

Mark Schubert nominated Jim Brown as moderator pro tem. This was seconded by Steve Hanson. There was no discussion and the nomination passed.

Don Kinney moved to accept the minutes from the January 10,2021 as presented. Mark Schubert seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed.

There were no additions to the Pastor's , the Moderator's, Diaconate, Stewardship/Outreach, and the Christian Education Reports. The Facilities committee had a concern. Skip Bratton informed us of the cost of snow removal. There was some discussion on possible ways to bring this cost down. A motion to approve the Reports was made by Debbie Tomicich and seconded by Don Kinney. The motion passed.

Mark Schubert presented the Financial Report for 2021. There was discussion on increasing the use of investments of the Hazel Chamberlain and Bob Moran Endowments. The Hazel Chamberlain endowment is restricted but the Bob Moran Endowment is not. Don Kinney requested that the Church Council make a decision on using the Bob Moran Endowment. The Budget for 2022 was approved last November. No vote was needed to approve.

Pastor Pam lead a discussion of Church Goals for 2022. We had small groups and then shared thoughts and ideas. She will use these ideas to set her goals so they are in concert with the goals of the congregation.

Ne business included the proposed revised By Laws and restrictions. There was discussion on trying to write the By Laws for who we are now as a Church. Also, on how to present the revisions to the congregation. Possibly one section at a time through the Weekly Wrangler.

No other New Business. The meeting was adjourned by Jim brown who lead the Benediction.
